



# Welcome to Bear Lake Wilderness Camp Upon your Arrival:

For your safety, comfort, and enjoyment, please follow the guidelines below during your visit.

- Note your Boat # and keep one flotation device per person, two paddles, and the sealed mandatory emergency kit in the boat at all times. If any item is missing please let us know so we can replace the item(s) needed.
- Please do not adjust equipment or the appliances. Ask for help.
- Unless your cabin's having a vicious poker game, don't worry about settling your bill on Saturday. We know where you live!
- **Do not place anything on top of fridge.** It will kick the pilot light off and it can be a bugger to relight.
- There are maps of each lake in the Tackle Shop. Just ask.
- Book your guided trips and reserve your 2 hp motors early as they are first come, first served.
- If you break, damage, or lose any equipment we will have to charge you for it. So please don't. We hate to do this and you won't be happy about it either.
- We make a grocery run into town every Tuesday. If you find that you forgot something or need anything, drop your list and a cooler by the lodge Monday. We will get what you need and you can reimburse us later.

## During your stay

For your safety, comfort, and enjoyment, please follow the guidelines below during your visit.

- You are welcome to join us for coffee in the morning after 7:00am. We normally keep a pot on all day...just drop in.
- We turn the generator on every evening at 6:00 pm. We normally turn it off after the 11:00 news. You are welcome to come up and watch T.V. with us. We will also be happy to recharge any item (fitting a 110v outlet) for you.
- Hot showers are always available to you at the shower house.
- Use the signup sheet/board in the lodge to use the outer lakes.
- Clean all fish in the fish cleaning facility **only!** Do not use the docks, shore or cottages.
- Please use the containers in your cabin for grease, table scraps, and garbage.
- Be mindful of open flames. Do not leave stove burners on and unattended at any time. Turn off all propane lights when leaving the cottage or retiring for the night.
- When passing through the “narrows” shut off the motor and lift the prop out of the water.
- Do not consume alcohol and operate a boat.
- No Open Flames – Except in the Portable Fire Places.

Please leave your cottage in the same clean order for the next guest. There is a \$50 cleaning fee for leaving a dirty cabin.

### Check Out Checklist:

- Boats and Equipment are to be turned in Friday by 6:PM. This is so we can service them and have them ready for guests Saturday Morning.
- Fridge emptied and cleaned out.
- Stove and counter top wiped down.
- Dishes, pots, and utensils washed & put away.
- Remove all food and garbage from cottage.
- Please have all your gear and luggage down on the dock at least 30 minutes before your scheduled departure.
